Congratulations— this landslide polling/vote (see attached email below) approving the funding of the HRMD01, further demonstrates the steadfast commitment of Heather Ridge Communities toward the mission to:

- Maintain the open space
- Protect the property values and
- Safeguard the quality of the community.

The HRMD01 was approved by the voters in the November 7, 2006 election by 85%. Now, today, the 86% approval of the budget enables the district to actively exist.

When we began this effort in the spring of 2005 our goals evolved into 3 areas:

- Keeping the residents involved and up to date on the activities,
- Reactive – Changing the Golf Course zoning from MULTI-FAMILY DEVELOPMENT to PLANNED DEVELOPMENT - GOLF COURSE,
