Aurora City Council meeting 2-27-2006 7:30 pm

Mayor Ed Tauer & City Council remarks prior to unanimous approval of the proposed Heather Ridge Metropolitan District Service Plan.

City Clerk: Agenda "Item 11 C. Consideration of a RESOLUTION of the City Council of the City of Aurora, Colorado, approving the Service Plan for Heather Ridge Metropolitan District Nos. 1, 2, and 3 and authorizing the execution of an Intergovernmental Agreement between the City and the Districts."

Mayor Tauer: "Council Woman Markert, this is mostly in your Ward . . ."

Councilwoman Markert: "Yes it mostly is . . . I'd like to move approval of item 11-C"

Councilwoman Sandstrom: "Second"

Mayor Tauer: "and so it is moved by councilwoman Markert and seconded by councilwoman Sandstrom, because the rest of it is in your ward, to approve Resolution 11-C. Discussion?"
